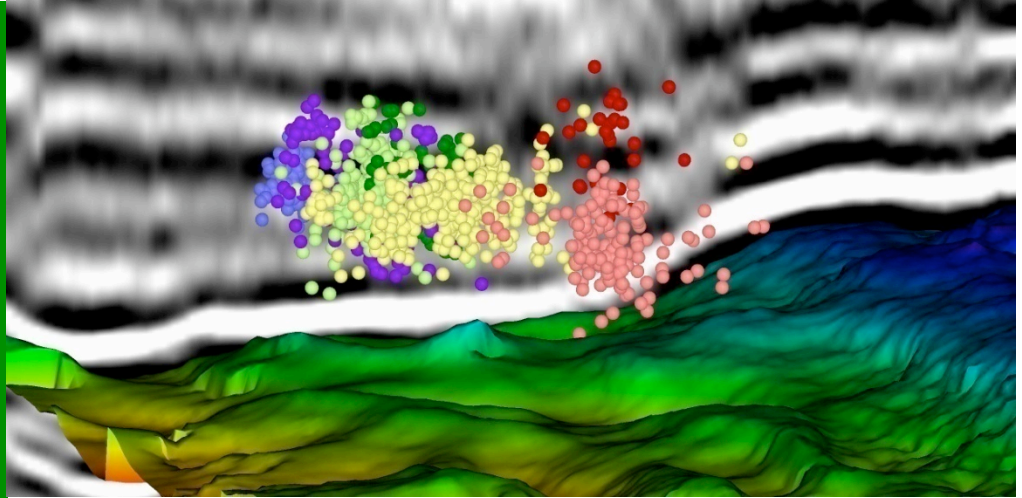

Abstracts should include sufficient detail for the committee to judge the quality of the paper. Abstracts should be a minimum 1 page text plus 1 figure and be formatted on "Letter" paper (8.5" x 11"). Oral and poster sessions will be offered. Abstract submission deadline is June 15th, 2009.

While no formal abstracts will be distributed, in order to encourage candor, presentations will be made in an "off-the-record" spirit. Participants will have the option to have their abstracts distributed, should they so desire.

Submission

Electronic submission is preferred (see website for details) in PDF format, however mail-in submissions are permitted provided they are received by the CSEG on or before July 15.
