**Making sense of local food, food safety, and healthy eating:  
Canadian farmwomen talk about food provisioning**

Farmwomen occupy a unique position in relation to non-farm women in that they are responsible for household food management as well as involved in raising or growing food for public consumption. This presentation draws on five publications based on an in-depth qualitative study of the food provisioning practices of 22 Canadian farmwomen. Our purpose is to stimulate critical reflection about the local food movement generally and as it pertains to food safety and healthy eating.

**Objectives:**

1. To demonstrate how a rich qualitative data set can be exploited for multiple research inquiries
2. To discuss the food provisioning construct as a way of understanding eating patterns distinct from traditional dietary techniques
3. To raise population health-related questions about food localism
