The Calgary International Airport is recognized as one of the top airports in the world and is a key gateway and major hub for both passengers and freight. This will be a joint presentation; Bob Schmitt will talk about the demands that resulted in the need for the Airport's expansion and work needed to maintain its international status, and John Charrett will give his structural engineering perspective for designing the \$350 million expansion to the Airport.

Mr. Bob Schmitt has been involved in the aviation industry for the past nineteen years. Previous work experience included land development and heavy construction activity throughout Western Canada. Bob held various positions with general contractors and engineering firms. Since joining the Calgary Airport community in 1987 working as a project manager for Transport Canada, he has held a number of management and senior management positions in the Calgary Airport Authority, and has been part of the executive team for the past nine years in the position of Vice President – Airport Development.

After completing his engineering education in London, England, John Charrett specialized in the design of precast concrete office buildings, grandstands and parking structures. The position of Project Engineer for the Calgary Exhibition and Stampede grandstand brought him to Canada, where he has subsequently worked on a variety of commercial, institutional, and industrial projects. John joined Read Jones Christoffersen Ltd. in 1988 and since 1997 is a Principal. He currently leads the structural engineering team in the design of the expansion to the Calgary International Airport.
