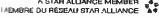

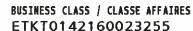

Although you may check in as early as 24 hours prior to departure, please note that **baggage** may only be checked in at the baggage drop-off counter at the earliest:

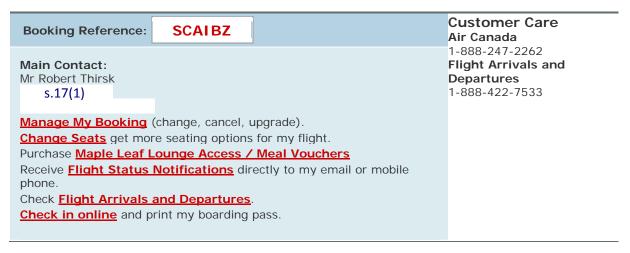

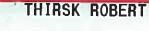
