Eligibility

For new enrolments, activation of a new Aeroplan membership may take up to 72 hours. The purchasing individual will be listed as the Flight Pass owner.
- Consumer flight passes are serviced for individual consumers only. 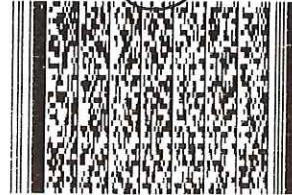

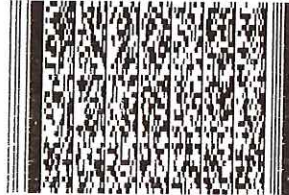
