Step 1 - Create an ApplyAlberta account

Beginning Oct. 1, you can start your application on the ApplyAlberta website, complete your profile, and select "University of Calgary."

Students applying from a Saskatchewan high school – please ensure you include your Saskatchewan Student Number in the ApplyAlberta section of the application. This will ensure your transcript is correctly matched with your application when you send it through MyCreds.

Step 2). The “Apply Now” button will take you to the Apply Alberta application portal. Select “Apply Now!” or “Login to Resume Application.” If you have not already done so, you will need to create an Alberta.ca account. Once you have completed this portion of the application, the information you entered will transfer to the University of Calgary application from (Step 3 and beyond).

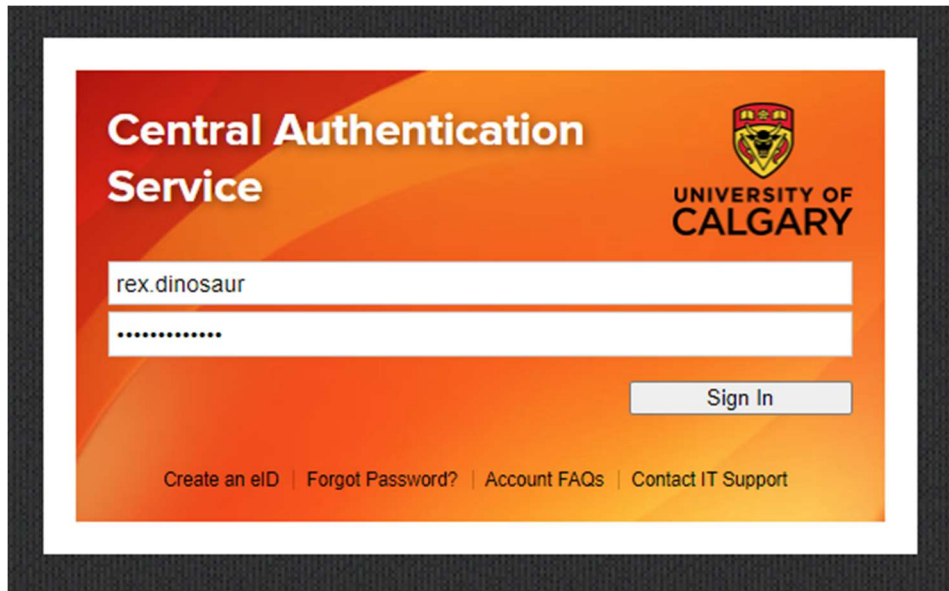
