#### How much is the application fee?

A non-refundable application fee of \$125.00 (CAD) will be charged for applicants who have attended institutions in Canada only. A non-refundable application fee of \$145.00 (CAD) will be charged for applicants who have attended institutions outside of Canada. You may pay your application fee by Visa, Mastercard or American Express at the end of this application or submit payment through an alternate paymen method. For Spring applications, the deadline for payment is February 1st. For Fall and Summer applications, the deadline for payment is March 1st.
