Hot work requirements are applicable to any temporary event that uses an open flame and generates smoke that will affect the fire alarm system. These events include any ceremony involving the burning of tobacco, sweet grass, or other ceremonial plants or incense in areas that have not been designed to accommodate smoke generation.

- Please allow three days minimum prior to the ceremonial event as portions of the fire alarm system may have to be deactivated (<u>hotworks@ucalgary.ca</u>)
- Ceremony can commence once the completed permit has been received and the area is properly posted.
- Persons responsible for causing fire alarms and subsequent business interruptions to the University of Calgary community by failing to abide by university policies and procedures will be invoiced in the amount of **\$1500**.
- One individual at the ceremony should be designated and trained in the proper use of fire extinguishers and how to activate the building alarm.
- All fires must be reported IMMEDIATELY to Campus Security.
