<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <u>Avalanche Awareness Courses</u> – lecture presentations only - <u>Bike Repair Clinic</u> - <u>Canoeing</u> – may take place at community lakes, Glenmore Reservoir or wilderness areas - <u>Climbing and Bouldering</u> - <u>Cross Country Skiing</u> – may take place at a school, a local park or Kananaskis Country - <u>Guiding Services</u> – provides guide services for hiking trips - <u>Hiking and Backpacking</u> - <u>In-Line Skating</u> - <u>Kayaking</u> – may take place at a school, community pool, Glenmore Reservoir, Bow River or if at the University's pool, it may also include facility rental - <u>Mountain Biking</u> – may take place on University endowment lands and/or other trail areas - <u>Outdoor Rock Climbing</u> - <u>Sea Kayaking</u> – may take place at a lake or if at the University's pool, it may also include facility rental - <u>Snowshoeing</u> – may take place at a school, a local park or Kananaskis Country - <u>Stand Up Paddleboarding</u> – may take place at community lakes or wilderness areas - <u>Telemark Skiing</u> – may take place at Wintergreen or Nakiska - <u>Whitewater Rafting and/or River Rafting</u> – may take place at the Glenmore Reservoir and/or in wilderness areas
