The application has five (5) components;

- Application form containing applicant details
- Community Service log outlining the applicant's involvement in various community service organizations or volunteer projects that benefit the community or individuals in need.
- A brief essay (maximum 300 words) to highlight the applicant's leadership experience either formally or informally to improve organizations, communities or causes in which they participate or support
- The opportunity to provide other information you believe relevant
- Confirmation of status as a full – time student in good standing (as defined by University and the program of studies) and returning to the University the following year.
