


The Unofficial Transcript contains information about academic history including: program, classes (both complete and in progress), grades, transfer credits, whether degree was conferred and conferral date
The following are instructions on how to view an Unofficial Transcript

Please ensure you have allowed pop-ups otherwise transcript will not populate

1. Log into MyUofC

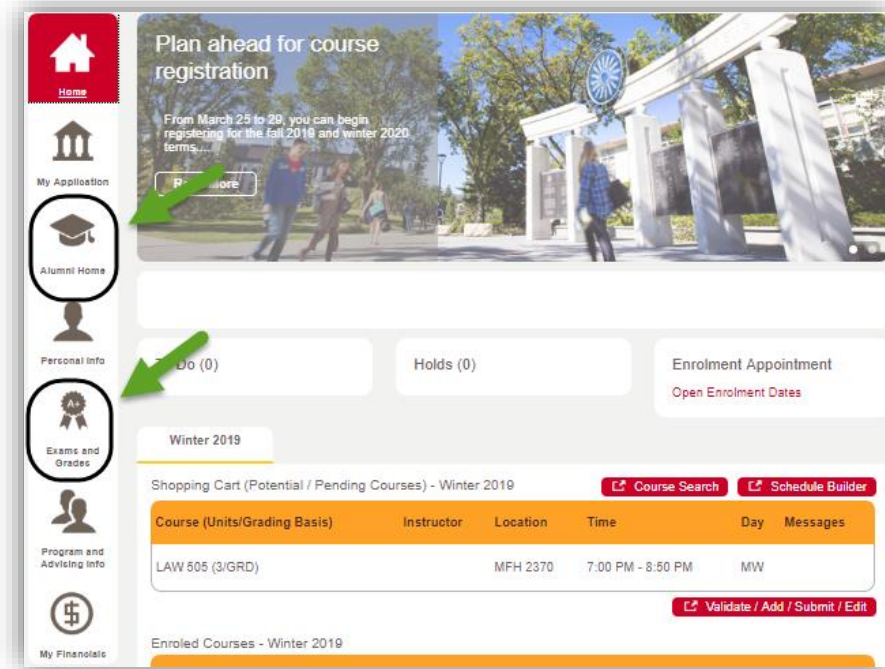

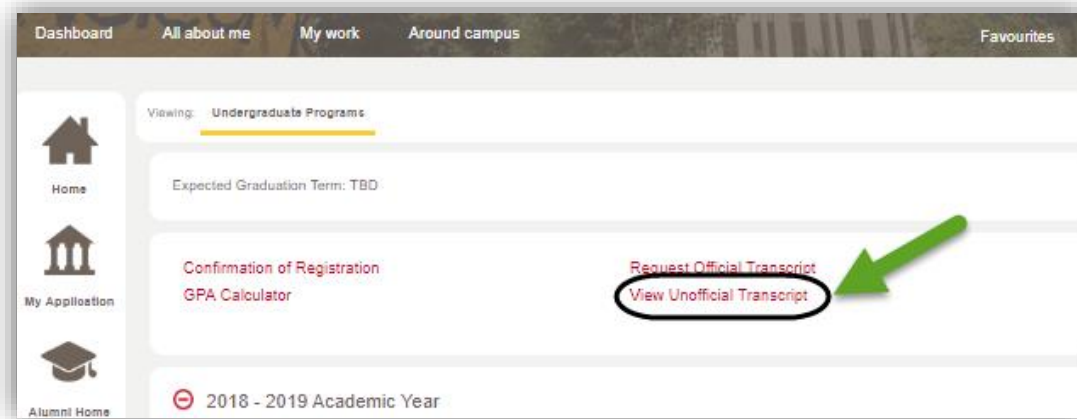
2. After logging into MyUofC portal

If you are a current student, you can request a transcript from the **Exams and Grades** page


If you are alumni, you can request a transcript from the **Alumni** page
