### **CHIN310**

#### **Topics in Chinese Culture in an Immersion Setting**

##### **Description**

An introduction to contemporary Chinese culture and functional Chinese language.

Prerequisite(s): Consent of the School of Languages, Linguistics, Literatures and Cultures.

Antirequisite(s): Credit for Chinese 309 and 310 will not be allowed.

Notes: May be offered as part of a group study program. Additional fees will be assessed to cover additional costs associated with this course.

### **CHIN280**

#### **Chinese Language in an Immersion Setting Beginners I**

##### **Description**

An introductory course in Chinese stressing oral and aural skills in an immersion setting.

Prerequisite(s): Consent of the School of Languages, Linguistics, Literatures and Cultures.

Antirequisite(s): Credit for Chinese 280 and 311 will not be allowed.

Notes: May be offered as part of a group study program. Additional fees will be assessed to cover additional costs associated with this course.

### **CHIN281**

#### **Chinese Language in an Immersion Setting Beginners II**

##### **Description**

Continuation of Chinese 280.

Prerequisite(s): Chinese 280.

Antirequisite(s): Credit for Chinese 281 and 313 will not be allowed.

Notes: May be offered as part of a group study program. Additional fees will be assessed to cover additional costs associated with this course.

### **CHIN304**

#### **Chinese Language in an Immersion Setting Continuing I**

##### **Description**

A continuing-level course in Chinese stressing oral and aural skills in an immersion setting.

Prerequisite(s): Consent of the School of Languages, Linguistics, Literatures and Cultures.

Antirequisite(s): Credit for Chinese 304 and 311 will not be allowed.

Notes: May be offered as part of a group study program. Additional fees will be assessed to cover additional costs associated with this course.

### **CHIN305**

#### **Chinese Language in an Immersion Setting Continuing II**

##### **Description**

Continuation of Chinese 304.

Prerequisite(s): Chinese 304.

Antirequisite(s): Credit for Chinese 305 and 313 will not be allowed.

### **CHIN334**

#### **Chinese Language in an Immersion Setting Intermediate I**

##### **Description**

An intermediate-level course in Chinese stressing oral and aural skills in an immersion setting.

Prerequisite(s): Consent of the School of Languages, Linguistics, Literatures and Cultures.

Antirequisite(s): Credit for Chinese 311 and 334 will not be allowed.

Notes: May be offered as part of a group study program. Additional fees will be assessed to cover additional costs associated with this course.

### **CHIN335**

#### **Chinese Language in an Immersion Setting Intermediate II**

##### **Description**

Continuation of Chinese 334.

Prerequisite(s): Chinese 334.

Antirequisite(s): Credit for Chinese 313 and 335 will not be allowed.

Notes: May be offered as part of a group study program. Additional fees will be assessed to cover additional costs associated with this course.
