In order for your exchange application to be considered complete, this supplementary form must be filled out and uploaded to your [RAISA online application](#), and the RAISA online application must be “submitted” by the deadline listed on the [UCalgary NSE website](#).

Prior to completing this form, please read the NSE [eligibility requirements](#) and [policies & procedures](#).

Search for campuses using the [alphabetical list](#) or the [NSE map](#), selecting UCalgary as your home school (this will remove or cross out any campuses that are unavailable to UCalgary students). Note, you may only apply to “Home Pay” campuses (which means you pay regular UCalgary tuition for the exchange).

When considering which campuses to apply to, please read the ENTIRE campus profile, scrolling down to the bottom and paying particular attention to:

- **Chance of placement:** You must apply to at least one OPEN/EXCELLENT rated campus in your top 3, and no more than one LIMITED school. If you have a LIMITED school, it must be #1 on your list.
- **Closed or limited subjects:** Some campuses have subjects that exchange students are not allowed to access at all or that are highly restricted for exchange students. You should not rely on course availability for these subjects and need to be flexible to take courses in other subject areas.
- **When will I register:** If this says course registration for exchange students is after regular students, again you need to be flexible with back-up courses, in case your preferred courses fill up before you can register.
- **Eligibility requirements:** Some campuses require a higher cumulative GPA.
- **International students:** Some campuses do not accept UCalgary students who have non-Canadian passports.
- **English requirements:** If English is not your first language, you may have to provide your TOEFL/IELTS score.
- **Semester limitations:** Some campuses only allow exchange students for specific semesters, or have rules if students can/cannot study there for a full year.

Students must list a **minimum of 3** and a **maximum of 5** NSE Campuses.
