- **The chance of placement at that school:** You must apply to at least one *EXCELLENT* rated school in your top 3 and no more than one *LIMITED* school. If you have a *LIMITED* school, it must be your top choice.
- **Closed programs:** some schools will have programs that students cannot apply to or take courses in.
- **Limitations:** some schools have departments that have strict limitations on the number of students that can take courses with them. You should be prepared to be flexible if you are going to try to take such courses as you may not be successful and must take a backup course from your course list.
- **GPA Requirements:** Some schools may have a higher GPA requirement for eligibility.
- **International visa students:** Some campuses may not accept you if you are an international University of Calgary student, meaning you have a visa to be studying in Canada or do not have a Canadian Passport.
- **English assessment requirements:** If English is not your first language you may have to provide them with your TOEFL or IELTS scores as proof of proficiency.
- **Semester limitations:** Some schools have limits on which semesters they will accept NSE students in or if there are rules if students can/cannot study there for a full year.

Students must list a **minimum of 3** and a **maximum of 8** NSE Exchange Institutions.
