




Can I use AI in my Coursework?

At the University of Calgary guidelines for AI use in coursework varies from course to course. Not all courses permit the use of AI tools in the completion of assignments and other assessments. As a student, it is your responsibility to understand instructors' expectations for each course. This flowchart is designed to help you determine if the use of AI tools is permitted for your courses. The flowchart is followed by a text-based decision guide.

AI Use Decision Guide

When determining if and how you can use AI in your coursework, ask yourself the following questions:

1. Is there a statement in your course syllabus or assignment instructions about AI use?

- If yes, go to Question 2.
- If no, talk to your instructor to clarify expectations around AI use.

2. Does the statement permit AI use?

- If yes, go to Question 3.
- If no, do not use AI, as it may violate academic integrity policies.

3. Does the statement include specific rules and regulations regarding AI use?

- If yes, go to question 4.
- If no, talk to your instructor about using AI to clarify expectations and avoid academic misconduct.

4. Do you understand these rules and the overall expectations in the course?

- If yes, you can use AI only as permitted. You must follow any specific guidelines or limitations, including any citation requirements.
- If no, discuss class expectations with your instructor to ensure you are using AI properly.
